UCCI constituted this Trust in 2002 under the Chairmanship of District Collector, Udaipur for development of disposal facility on set apart land. Representatives of associations like Bhiwadi Manufacturer's Association, Rajasthan Chamber of Commerce & Industry, Jaipur, Vishwakarma Industries Association, Jaipur, Rajasthan Textile Processors Association, Bhilwara and MSME Association, Udaipur are among the Trustees of UIWM&RC.

### **Rajasthan Waste Management Project (RWMP)**

Rajasthan Waste Management Project (RWMP), which is a one of a kind hazardous waste management facility operating in Rajasthan and caters to over 1100 industrial units which generate hazardous waste.

RWMP was established by the initiative of Rajasthan State Pollution Control Board, Jaipur to create a Common Hazardous Waste Treatment, Storage & Disposal Facility (CHW-TSDF) for waste generators of Rajasthan under directives of Supreme Court dated 14th Oct 2003. RSPCB granted the permission to UCCI as a Promoter to develop a landfill facility in Gudli, Udaipur. For this purpose, the land was leased to Udaipur Industrial Waste Management & Research Center.

The project was started in the year 2005 as M/s Ramky Enviro Engineers Ltd., Hyderabad was chosen to be the Operator for the facility on 'Built, Own, Operate and Transfer (BOOT)' basis.

The Rajasthan Waste Management Project Pvt. Ltd. came into operation in October 2006. The CHW-TSDF, situated at RWMP, Udaipur in 21 acres of land, comprises of a Secured Landfill Facility, Waste Treatment & Stabilization Facility, State of the Art Laboratory, Ultramodern waste Transportation Vehicles, Temporary Waste Storage and other related components.
